



Multiplex Conference on the Future of Europe Event

Objectives of the event

The multiplex event will bring together local and regional authorities and citizens in their respective regions/municipalities to discuss about the future of their municipality/region and identify the issues most prominent to the citizens in their municipality/region and how they can be solved on both the local/regional level as well as with the help of the EU. Important here is to reach some conclusions of what the citizens want the EU to be responsible for and what not.

The proposals and conclusions of the event will be submitted to the Conference on the Future of Europe, to be included in the final recommendations.

Participating local and regional authorities will gather with the invited citizens in a location of their choice in their region/municipality. They will connect online via Interactio for the introductory and concluding sessions. For the individual citizens' dialogues (18:30 – 19:45) they will disconnect and discuss with their citizens online/in-person at the chosen location/online platform.
